

### **Common Industry Terms**

**Non Combustible:** Coating materials tested to AS 1530.1 are typically cement-based and are only suitable as a base levelling coat for use over concrete, brick & block work and AAC autoclaved aerated concrete.

**Weatherproofing:** Roof and external wall compliance with F3P1 to prevent water penetration. F3D5 references the standards for external walls as Deemed to Satisfy solutions (DtS).

**Textured Paint:** Is the aesthetic finish that looks like a render coating and by virtue of its composition & method of application, can produce a variety of rough, sandy, patterned textured finishes (by heavy brush, roller or trowel).

**External waterproofing:** Intended to minimize the risk of water leaking into or accumulating within a building causing unhealthy conditions or damaging building elements by corrosion or rot.
